The Ninth Annual Ten Commandment Hike is going to held on Saturday, October 29 here in Lewisville Texas and many of the local churches will be participating in the Hike.



The hike is being sponsored by the Longhorn Council, Boy Scouts of America and is open for all to attend. Participants who register for the walk will receive a official Ten Commandment patch to commemorate the event. Registration begins at 8:00 am and the program starts at 9:00 am.



Participants should arrive by 8:45. Drivers should drop off hikers at the start point with adult supervision, then drive to the end-point (maps will be provided). The marchers will reach the halfway point at approximately 12:30. This is when we will pause for lunch. Hikers should bring a sack lunch and water in a daypack. We expect to finish around 2:30 pm. Groups of 8 or more may pre-register to carry the Ark containing the 10 Commandments.
